RESOLUTION # 3

BE IT RESOLVED that that Hadley Town Board hereby approves the Post Star for legal ads and information.

RESOLUTION # 5

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hadley Town Board has chosen to deposit Town Funds in the Arrow Bank.

RESOLUTION # 6
